



More than 4 000 learners benefit from Matric examination preparation camps

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4 176 Grade 12 learners from 51 schools located in host communities (City of Joburg, Matjhabeng Local Municipality, Moqhaka Local Municipality, Mogale City Local Municipality, Merafong City Local Municipality, City of Matlosana and Ratlou Local Municipality) have benefited from the annual Matric examination preparation camps programme Harmony is running with the Department of Education (DOE).

The Matric camps run from March 2024 to November 2024 and are aimed at providing an enabling environment for Grade 12 learners to prepare for their final examinations without interruptions with access to learner support.

The DOE believes that the Matric camps contribute significantly to improving pass rates, particularly in maths and science.

Harmony's contribution was vital towards logistics associated with hosting the camps including accommodation, food, transport, security and stationery.

The District Departments of Education in the various provinces are responsible for selecting learners and allocating teachers to supervise the learners while they attend the camp.
