Empowerment through procurement with Hamisa Engineering and Mining Group

Harmony continues to demonstrate its commitment to supporting women empowerment and preferential procurement through a supplier agreement with Hamisa Engineering and Mining group (Hamisa).

As part of this initiative, Hamisa will supply personal protective equipment (PPE) to nearly 50% of Harmony's operations, including key shafts such as Kusasaletu, Target Mine, and Tshepong Plant.

This partnership follows a rigorous tender process, where Hamisa stood out due to its proven track record, including the successful ad-hoc supply of consumables to Doornkop since 2014.

About Hamisa Engineering and Mining group

Founded in 2010, Hamisa is a 100% black and majority women-owned business with a BBBEE Level 1 empowerment rating. The company has grown notably, their offices in Johannesburg, Mpumalanga, and Bloemfontein now employ 155 people, primarily youth, and operates manufacturing facility in Parrow (Cape Town).

Their equipment supply is supported by free training in the correct product use and after care service.

Harmony's support has unlocked new opportunities for Hamisa, including the expansion of their operations at Lanseria. Through this project, Hamisa has reduced its reliance on outsourcing, increasing its manufacturing capacity. Funding for the expansion, totalling R49 million, was secured from the Industrial Development Corporation (IDC) and Department of Trade Industry and Competition (DTI), further strengthening their growth path.

This partnership not only uplifts women entrepreneurs but also creates meaningful economic opportunities within Harmony's host communities. Together, Harmony and Hamisa are building a legacy of transformation, empowerment, and sustainable growth.
